CAMPFIRES between the hours of 16:00 to 23:00 hours only.

Campfires to be within a steel, brick or rock ring not exceeding one metre in diameter.

Town of Comox Bylaw #1556, Fire Prevention & Regulation Bylaw

1. The permittee shall appoint a "Fire Warden" who will be responsible to ensure that ALL conditions of this permit are followed.
2. The Fire Warden shall ensure that the ventilation index for CENTRAL VANCOUVER ISLAND is rated FAIR or GOOD for the day before allowing campfires on the property.
Phone 1-888-281-2992 to get Ventilation Index for CENTRAL VANCOUVER ISLAND.
A sign or signs shall be posted informing campers whether "CAMPFIRES are ALLOWED TODAY" or "NO CAMPFIRES TODAY".
3. **Campfires are NOT allowed within 3 metres of other combustible materials including tents, trailers and vegetation. At least one adult must be in attendance, at all times while the campfire is burning. Campfires cannot be left unattended.**
4. Only clean fire wood is to be used for campfires. No prohibited materials are to be burned including garbage, tires, oil, tar, plastics, asphalt shingles, waste from demolition or construction, and other substances prohibited by the provincial "Open Burning Smoke Control Regulations".
5. The permittee shall be responsible for all fire departments costs incurred to suppress any campfires that escape, threaten to escape or do not conform to the conditions of this permit.
6. **CAMPFIRES SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SMOULDER. Extinguish with water after use.**
7. **CONTRAVENTION of these conditions will result in cancellation of this permit.**
